Maths and English are taught four times a week.

Children are expected to read at least three times a week, this does not need to be a whole book. Please ensure each read is logged on BoomReader.

Children on Accelerated Reader are expected to quiz once that book has been completed and will receive a raffle ticket for achieving 100%.

Please make sure your child brings to school their reading book every day for Independent Reading.

Rewards:

For following our Academy Rules or for great learning children are given Dojo points.

Every Friday we reveal who the Dojo Leader of the Week is and give that person a Headteacher's Prize.

For completing Home Learning, Dojos are awarded.

Positive Behaviour time; children who have been fantastic learners all week will get all thirty minutes of their Positive Behaviour time.

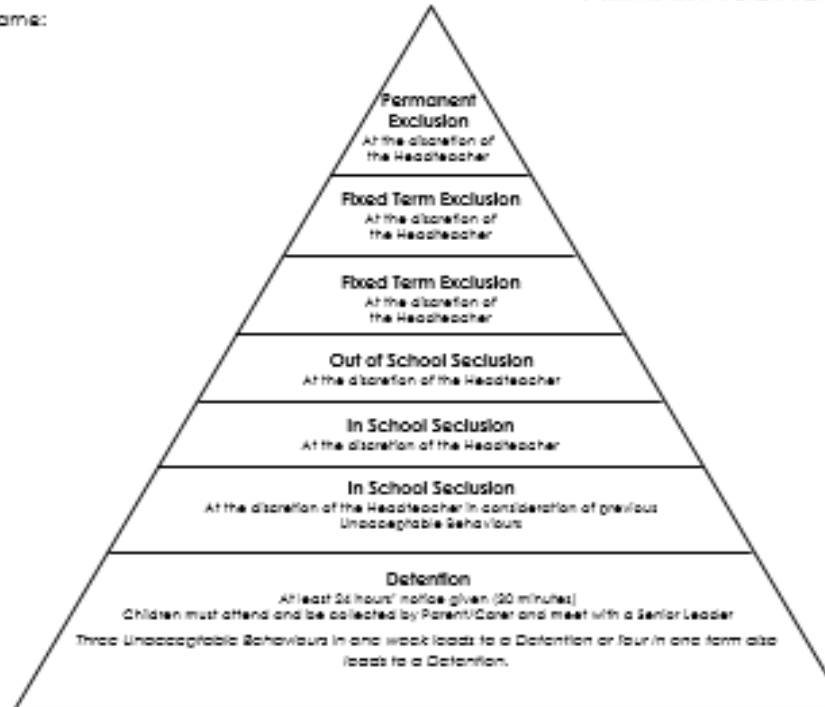
