The termly topics will underpin wider curriculum lessons and as you can see, it will alternate each term between History and Geography based topics.



School uniform should consist of a white polo shirt, Academy jumper/cardigan with logo on, dark grey trousers/shorts/skirt/dress, grey or navy tights and/or white, grey or black socks and black school shoes please.

Please ensure your child's name is on all of their items of clothing and belongings, thank you.



Children in Year 6 will continue to read using **Accelerated Reader** - a computer program that helps teachers manage and monitor children's independent reading practice as well as encouraging and motivating children to read.

We expect children to be reading 5 times a week with an adult and logging this on the Boom Reader App, which is monitored by their class teacher.

Reading books will need to be brought in daily, as we will have various opportunities for children to independently read, as well as reading with an adult. There will also be opportunities for children to quiz and change their reading book.

Rewards:

For following our Academy Rules or for great learning children are given Dojo points.

Every Friday we reveal who the Dojo Leader of the Week is and give that person a Headteacher's Prize.

For completing Home Learning, Dojos are awarded.

Positive Behaviour time; children who have been fantastic learners all week will get all thirty minutes of their Positive Behaviour time.

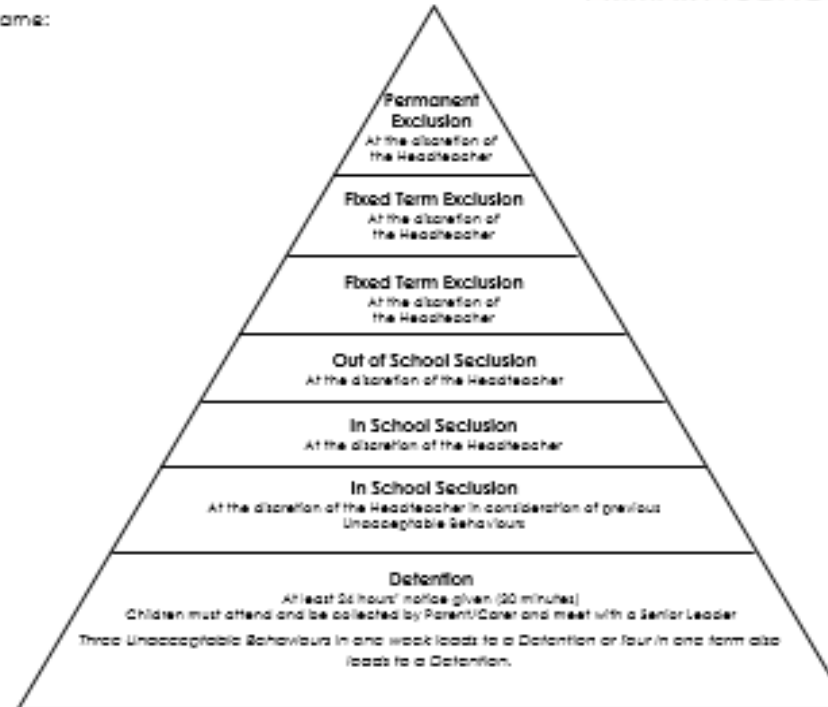
