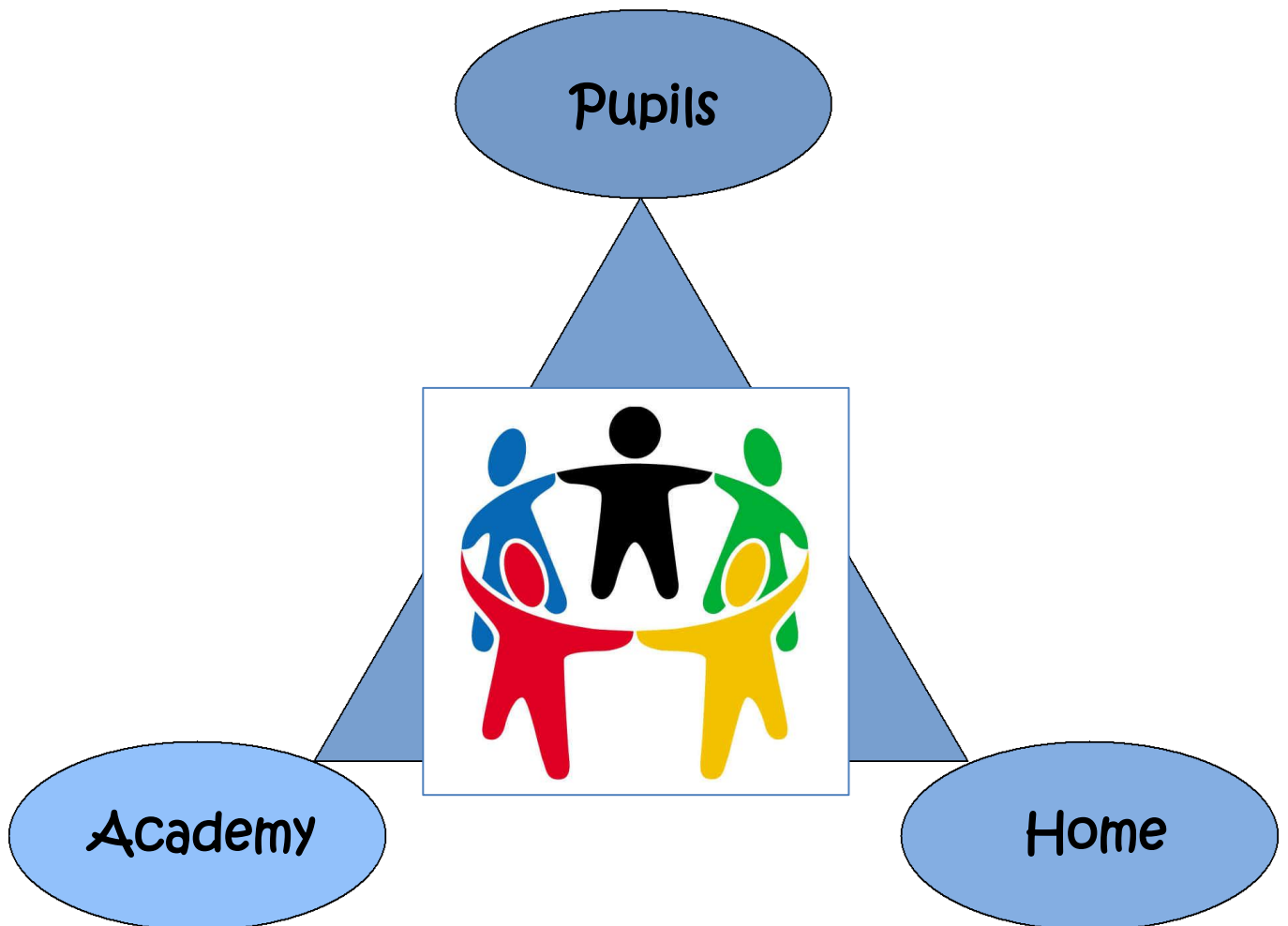


Home School Agreement
