This week saw the Academy Council travel to London to visit the Houses of Parliament. This was a truly inspiring day and the children's behaviour was excellent; they were a real credit to the Academy. The children learnt about the different Houses that make up Parliament and had the opportunity to ask our local MP, Johnny Mercer, some questions including 'Do you want to be the Prime Minister one day?' and 'Is Theresa May nice?' Afterwards, they went on the London Eye and watched the sunset over Big Ben.

Here is a run down of the day... The Representatives had a very hectic start - due to a traffic hold-up in the morning and only just made the train to London! However, from then, on everything went like clockwork. The children were really sensible, particularly as we moved from Paddington Station to Westminster via the Tube; a brisk walk to Parliament and then two hours being taken around the buildings and having a role play session in the Education Centre. They then had a very quick walk to the London Eye which was a unique experience for everyone, made more special by the lights of London coming on, as it became dark.

A quick McDonald's and another journey on a Tube - which became increasingly busy as they got nearer Paddington. The train journey home passed without problem, apart from being a few minutes late. A huge thank you to the Parents/Carers who were all waiting to pick up their tired but excited children and a big thank you to all of the Representatives who made us so proud to be part of Marine Academy Primary! We hope to replicate this trip again later in the academic year for other children to attend!

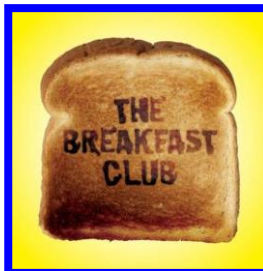
