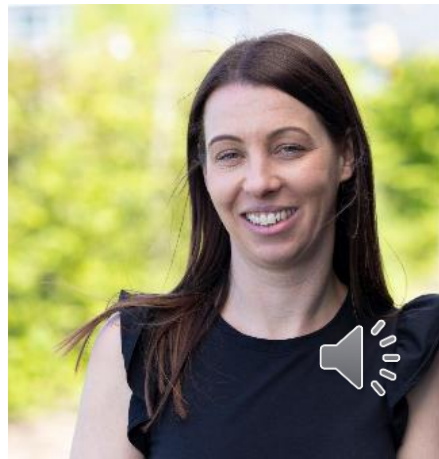

For following our Academy Rules or for great learning children are given Dojo points.

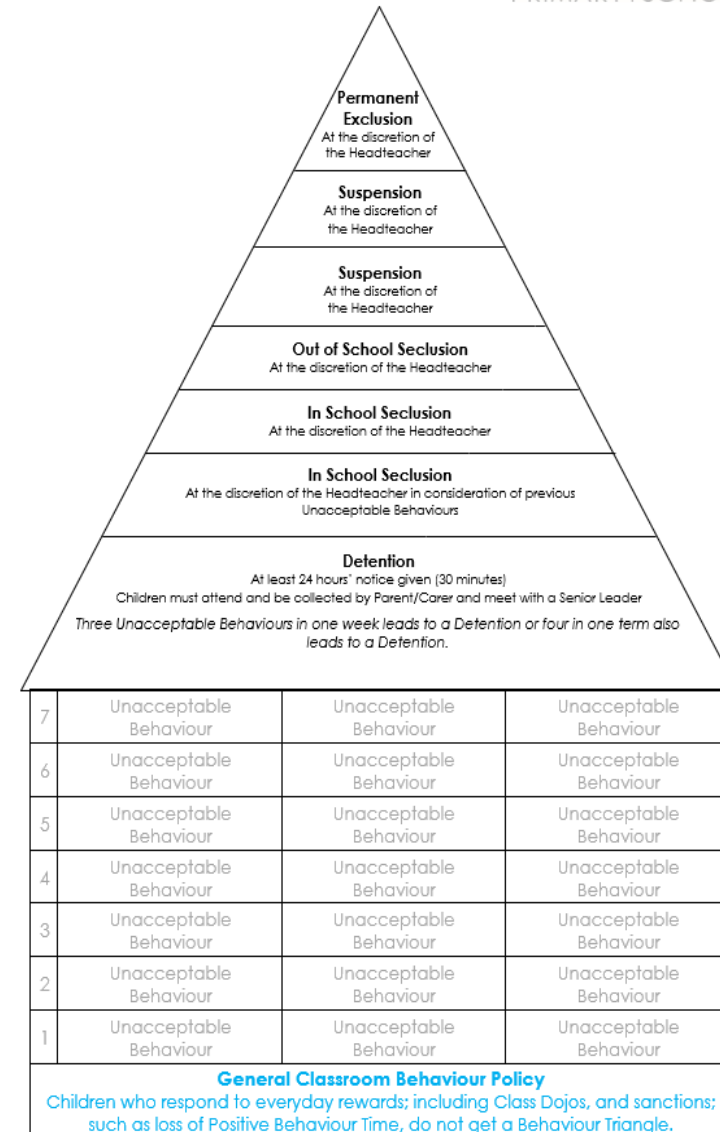
Every Friday we reveal who the Dojo Leader of the Week is and give that person a Headteacher's Prize.
